Job Description

We are seeking synthetic organic chemists to join rapidly developing company, as part of Chemical Research and Development. The position is responsible for the development of process technology and synthesis methods for the production of active pharmaceutical ingredient (API). The position engages in all facets of early development from small scale synthesis in support of Discovery programs to the development of enabling routes for larger scale production. The organic chemist will partner with manufacturing specialists for cGMP manufacturing of materials utilized in clinical trials and pilot scale plant production.

The successful candidate will assist in the design and execution of synthetic routes to drug candidates and assist in the development and completion of experimental studies to provide scalable processes for organic and contract manufacturing opportunities. Preparative scale up experience, product purification, and in process analytical testing, and parametric assessment are a plus.

A good knowledge of organic chemistry, strong laboratory skills including analytical techniques, and a commitment to safety is required. The candidate should be able to contribute to multi-disciplinary teams involving chemists, analysts, engineers, regulatory and technologists, as well as have an interest in applying new technology to process development.
